

What is a Delegation?

The Delegation



A group of members who act as **volunteers,** coordinated by a Head of Delegation and with specific roles

A point of reference for members in a given territory

FAI Group



Active volunteers group created by the Regional President and the Head of Delegation in answer to the needs of territory (may become a delegation)

The Local Committees



Created in 2003 to respond to **legal and fiscal issues** deriving from the activities of the Delegations.

What does a Delegation do?

Major national events

FAI Spring Days, FAI Autumn Day, Places I Love survey, Winter School Mornings



Local initiatives: *Puntiamo i riflettori*, care of small properties, FAI Golf Cup, events and lectures, etc.



Young FAI Groups: how it all started

- Since 2010, strongly wanted by the delegations
- At first, it involved youngsters from age 18 to age 40
- Strategic project within a process of renovation and repositioning strategy of FAI on a local and national level



University Students (18-25 year olds)

Focus on raising awareness about FAI's mission, involving young people in events (trekking, sports events, bicycle tours, predinner aperitifs) as well as a relationship with Universities and local and national youngsters organizations Young Professionals (26-40 year olds) Specific approach on young professionals with more focused events linked to professional growth and networking with a cultural backdrop. Would serve a recruitment method for the future delegations

- Maximum age of 35 since 2016
- Young people 18-35 for events and projects for young members
- Their focus is to
 - 1. Educate and raise awareness on FAI's mission

Young FAI Groups: the basics



- Spontaneous
- Coordinated by young delegate
- At least 5 volunteers
- Have a start-up budget of € 400
- Events for young members
- Official e-mail address on FAI's website
- Use only social network
- Specific logo
- Administration issues managed by Committee
- Duration as that of Delegation





- Universities: 55 internship agreements
- Apprendisti Ciceroni ®
- Recruitment Campaings (events and social networks)
- FAI Summer Camps

Young FAI Groups: some numbers after 6 years




- 86 Young FAI Groups in Italy, between 18 and 35 years old
- 800 active volunteers involved in the promotion of FAI's mission + 300 in the properties
- 290 events organized in 2016 by Young FAI Groups, with 17,500 participants
- 81 Groups on Facebook, with over 86,000 fans
- 40 associations in their network (young professionals, Rotaract, Leo Club, young lawyers, etc.)
- **55 universities** involved
- **30 years** is average age of young volunteers






