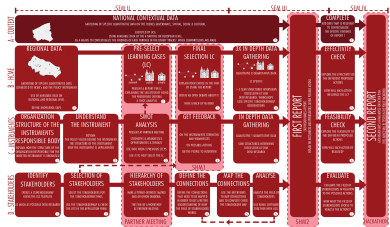
Third partner meeting

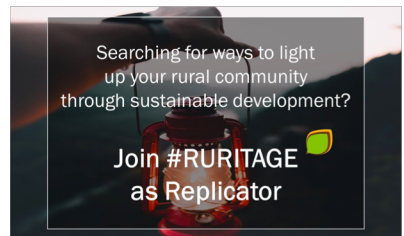
