Case Study: In 2017, the Saint Lucia National Trust discovered the government was proposing the development of a dolphinarium within the Pigeon Island National Trust site. The Trust's Director Bishnu Tulsie reached out to INTO for support. The INTO secretariat and our members responded to their call for assistance with case studies and guidance on mobilising international support. Two years on, the dolphinarium has not been approved.
